Scientific Writing and Oral Communication

This course is designed to help scientists with academic writing and communication. Among other topics, the lectures will cover dissertation writing and manuscript publication, including preparation (structure, scientific style, linguistic strategies to express opinions, summarize, show disagreement, etc.) and submission (choosing a journal, the peer review process, correspondence with editors, etc.). Additionally, the course aims to foster skills in delivering effective poster and slide presentations, featuring preparation (structure, design, rehearsals, etc.) and delivery (engaging the audience, body language, handling questions, etc.). Participants can expect down-to-earth advice and readily usable resources that are a crucial part of a scientist's toolkit.
