Milestones and tasks of ETH students

Task/Milestone in DissGo	ETH students
Thesis committee (as soon as possible, no later than 6 month after start of your thesis)	Use form 'BioMed ThesisCommittee' <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit form to BioMed coordinator as soon as possible but no later than 6 months after start of your thesis Complete DissGo as soon as possible but no later than 6 months after start of your thesis
Research proposal (before 1 st meeting)	Use form 'BioMed_Proposal' <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit form to BioMed coordinator as soon as possible but no later than 6 months after start of your thesis Submit form to all members of your committee before first committee meeting. Upload onto DissGo as soon as possible but no later than 6-12 months after start of your thesis. It is recommended to combine the doctoral plan and aptitude colloquium at the ETHZ with the research proposal and first thesis committee meeting for the BioMed program
Progress reports (2 nd meeting and up)	Use form 'BioMed_Report' <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit form to BioMed coordinator before each committee meeting Submit form to all members of your committee before each committee meeting Upload onto DissGo before each meeting
Minutes of Committee Meetings (all meetings) Time frame of meetings: 1 st : after 6-12 months 2 nd : after 1.5-2 years 3 rd : after 2.5-3 years 4 th : after 3.5-4years	Use form 'BioMed_Minutes' <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit signed form to BioMed coordinator after each meeting Upload onto DissGo after each meeting 3rd meeting: student has to pass the internal 'defense' of the project (see guidelines)
Collection of ECTS See BioMed guidelines	Collection of 12 ECTS; no form available Complete DissGo and myStudies with course work
